



Convection Oven Long Term Shut Down Procedure

- 1. Clean Oven Using Normal Practice.**
- 2. Power the Oven Off.**
 - a. This can be done by turning the Mode Switch to the off position.
 - b. Note: Electric ovens may have a circuit breaker at the bottom of the control panel, and this should be turned off after powering down.
- 3. Gas Ovens - Turn the Gas Off.**
 - a. At the wall turn the gas supply off. Make sure the gas valve lever is perpendicular to the pipe.
- 4. Disconnect Power to the Oven.**
 - a. For Gas Oven unplug the 115v cord from the wall outlet.
 - b. For Electric ovens power it off at the main circuit breaker.
 - i. This will either be directly behind the oven or at the main Breaker Panel.
 - ii. If the oven has a cord and plug, disconnect from outlet.
- 5. Leave the Door(s) Partially Open.**
 - a. This will allow the oven cavity to cool and dry out properly.
 - b. This will also help keeping the door gaskets in peak shape.
