



Long-term Shut Down Quick Guide

Preparing your Nieco Broiler for temporary closure or long-term Shut Down is simple. These steps ensure that the Broiler will be ready to quickly and safely return to service.

<h2>Prep</h2>	<p>Allow the broiler to run free of product for 10 minutes before turning it off. This allows any residue to burn off the chains.</p>
<h2>Disconnect</h2>	<p>Turn off the MAIN POWER SWITCH on the broiler. Close the MAIN GAS VALVE. TIP: Valve is closed when it is perpendicular to the pipe. Disconnect broiler power plug.</p>
<h2>Cool</h2>	<p>Allow broiler to cool for 30 minutes to begin Disassembly and Cleaning Procedures Always leave the ventilation hood on during the 30 minute cool down period.</p>
<h2>Clean</h2>	<p>Clean broiler according to standard Disassembly and Cleaning Procedures Allow all parts to air dry after cleaning, then reassemble.</p>



These steps ensure that the Broiler should be clean, disconnected from all power, with all gas valves closed in the OFF position for the offline period.
